

# Chaperon Policy

## P4A and Performing and Fine Arts Academy Events

Thank you for volunteering to participate and complete your parent hour participation commitment by chaperoning one of the many Performing and Fine Arts (PFAA) or Parents for the Arts (P4A) events.

Duties of chaperon(s) may include but are not limited to:

1. Arriving prior to the event to assist with set up
2. Actively watching/participating in the chaperoning of the event
  - a. No talking or texting on cell phone,
  - b. Arriving at scheduled time
  - c. Staying for full commitment
3. Actively manning an entrance/exit of the event
4. Assisting with selling of products during the event
5. Assisting with clean up after the event

Below are the guidelines that each chaperon must follow and adhere to.

1. All chaperons MUST be 18 years of age;
2. All Chaperons MUST be approved as a chaperon **before** arriving at the event;
3. No Chaperon may bring any additional child(ren) unless that child(ren) is attending the event as a PFAA student;
  - a. Or paid attendee being supervised by someone other than chaperon
4. P4A and PFAA representatives reserve the right to ask any chaperone(s) to leave should the chaperon not be fulfilling the necessary duties asked of them.
5. All chaperons agree to actively participate in the supervision of all attendees of the event.
  - a. Intervening if student/attendee behavior is inappropriate
6. All chaperons will respect and enforce all rules set forth by the school administration; school employee representative; or P4A executive board member or representative.
